Campus Coach Role

Defined: An adult leader involved in a local church who helps coach the student leaders of the First Priority club.

A coach does not play in the game and is not even allowed on the field during play. The coach is just that, he or she gives guidance, direction and advice to the student leaders in the club. The law of Equal Access gives students the right to initiate and lead the club on campus. Your job is to help them be successful. You direct students to lead in the HOPE cycle. You put students in the right positions to help them find fulfillment and the club to be successful.

- * Pray and encourage the student leaders and your church body to pray for the club.
- * Help the student leaders plan out the weekly club meetings.
- * Make sure the students have all the resources necessary to run the club.
- * Help the follow up team to encourage new Christians to get plugged into a local church.
- * Be involved in a local church student pastor network
