Faculty Sponsor Role

Defined: A school employee who opens their room for the First Priority club meetings. They help the students stay within compliance of the Equal Access law and act as a liaison on behalf of the students to the school administration.

The faculty sponsor is someone who volunteers their time to help students facilitate the club on campus. As a faculty member you are given the role of 'custodial' for the club. Much like a custodian of a building, you are the custodian of club leadership. This means that you help take care of all the behind the scenes details to ensure the club runs smoothly but nobody knows you are there. As a faculty sponsor of a club you can put time, energy, and effort into the students leading the club and act on their behalf for the school administration.

- * Attend club meetings as required under Equal Access Act (20 U. S. C. 4071-74)
- * Make sure the club functions in accordance with policies of the school.
- * Make sure the meeting room is open and ready before weekly club meeting.
- * Attend planning meetings
- * Help keep record of attendance.
