

LET ME HEAR YOU ROAR

OVERVIEW

Students take on the roles of animals in this funny and energetic version of the classic game *Rock, Paper, Scissors*.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

• All of your middle schoolers and Small Group Leaders

H O W - T O

PREP

Nothing. Woo-hoo!

PLAY

First, ask all of your students and Small Group Leaders to get into their small groups. Once in their groups, ask the students to form a circle around their Small Group Leader. The SGL begins the game by placing their hands on their knees and starting to growl (GRRR). At that signal, those in the circle will also growl.

Once everyone in the circle has joined in the growling, the SGL springs up and makes one of the following animal signs: bear (hands up in the air like paws), snake (arms straight out), rabbit (two pointer fingers on head), or shark (arms making a chomping motion). At the same time, everyone in the circle will also make an animal sign of a bear, snake, rabbit, or shark. Whoever makes the same animal sign as the SGL is out, but everyone else remains in the game.

Continue playing by choosing a new person to step into the middle of the circle each round. The last person standing is the winner.
