Today is **Equip Week** where we are teaching and having conversations about ways that Jesus embodied **truth**. Let's pray before we get started.

There are a lot of misconceptions about Who Jesus is. During His life many people falsely accused Him. Many people do the same today. Much of this comes from hearing what other people say about Him instead of reading the biographies about Him in the Bible. Many people think that God would never love them. Jesus showed us the opposite. He showed us exactly what God is like. He loved all people, cared for the poor, healed the sick, and hurt with those who were suffering. Finally, He died to save all of us from evil and rose again so we could have new life.

In John 14:6 Jesus told him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me.

Let's look at three main points about the truth that Jesus showed us:

- God loves and values everyone.
- God cares for the hurting and hopeless.
- All people are invited to have a relationship with God through lesus.

Big Idea: Our purpose is to help others know the Good News about Who Jesus is.

Today is **Invite Week** where we are teaching and having conversations about how **truth** is Good News. Let's pray before we get started.

The Good News of Jesus is a big claim! The early followers of Jesus said that He was crucified and died. But, then they saw Him alive again. Can you imagine what it would take to believe that someone had died and rose again? This is what one follower of Jesus wrote down about the story.

1 Corinthians 15:3-8 says, "I passed on to you what was most important and what had also been passed on to me. Christ died for our sins, just as the Scriptures said. He was buried, and He was raised from the dead on the third day, just as the Scriptures said. He was seen by Peter and then by the Twelve. After that, He was seen by more than 500 of His followers at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have died. Then He was seen by James and later by all the apostles. Last of all, as though I had been born at the wrong time, I also saw Him."

Many of these people ended up being killed because they so strongly believed that Jesus was alive from the dead. They shared this story with others, and more people kept believing.

The Gospel is a public, royal announcement about Jesus, Who lived, died, and was raised to life to be the King that we so desperately need. All who believe in Him receive forgiveness, new life, and hope for the future. Jesus is making all things new, setting right what is wrong, and bringing Good News to everyone who receives it. You are invited to believe this Good News and follow Jesus.

For this section, get into groups of 3-5 and go through the discussion questions, challenge, Bible Project video, and pray together.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- What are your thoughts about the claims that Jesus lived, died, and rose from the dead?
- What do you think it would have taken for this group of people to believe that Jesus was alive even after they saw Him crucified and buried?
- Why do you think so many people believe this story today and follow Jesus and His teachings?
- What questions do you have about the story of Jesus' life, death, and resurrection?

CHALLENGE

What if people knew they were loved and began a relationship with God because you shared the Good News through your acts of love and kindness. Be Jesus' love for someone this week and do something kind for someone.
