EPIC is a four week cycle that repeats every month. Each week has a specific focus that will equip your team to lead a large or small group of peers in your school.

The four weeks are designed to be rhythms to accomplish the mission of taking the hope of Christ to every student each month.



The focus of this week is on being equipped to see the mission of Jesus and how you can be a leader who follows His example.

The focus of this week is on being prepared to listen to the story of others and sharing your own story.



The focus of this week is on inviting students to experience the Good News of Jesus.



The focus of this week is on connecting students into a faith community.
