

## SYNC UP

Number of Students: Minimum of 4 (two groups of 2)

Have 2 students come up from each team. Have them stand back to back with their teammate.
You are then going to give them a prompt (similar to the Anomia/Tongue Tied clues). After you give them a prompt (i.e. Type of dog) you say, "3, 2, 1, GO" and then they jump around to face each other and they have to shout their answer at the same time. If they both say the same answer (i.e. - "Dalmation!") then they get a point. If they say different things (i.e. - one says "Poodle" and the other says "Pug") then they don't get a point. Whichever pair gets the most points wins for their team. You can do multiple rounds with multiple pairs to make it more fun.

Here are some examples of prompts that work well:
Type of shark, a theme park, a social media app, a vegetable, etc.
Make sure your clues aren't so broad that it would be nearly impossible to guess the same answer. Similarly, don't make it so simple that there are only a couple viable answers.
