Foundation Scripture

"For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures..."

1 Corinthians 15:3-4



HOST

"Welcome to First Priority! So far we have learned about who Jesus is, why we need salvation, and how we become saved. This week we want to look at the answer to the question we left you with last week - **what does all of that mean for me?** Before we get started, let's pray."

OPENING PRAYER



SPEAKER

"The best way we can answer the question: "what does salvation mean for me?" is by looking at what the Bible says, so let's read Ephesians 2:8-9. (*Small group discussion*)

According to those verses, let's talk about these questions:

- What is our part in salvation?
- Can we earn our salvation?
- How is our salvation a gift?
- If salvation is a gift, how should that change the way we talk about Jesus with others?

"If you know Jesus as your Savior, take a few minutes to reflect on all that Jesus has saved you from. You can think of this as a receipt like you would get from the grocery store, but instead of the cost of each item like bananas or milk, your items could be sin, shame, anger, mistakes, and more. Beside each of your "items" is the word "PAID" because Jesus paid the price for all of those things separating you from God."
