PREPARE WEEK

Preparing to reach your school and community with the Good News of Jesus.



4. **Praying for the lost**: We all have friends or family who are lost and do not know Jesus as their Savior. When we pray for the lost, we ask God to do what only He can do - move in the hearts of people so that they will receive His Son Jesus as their Savior.

SPEAKER

These four types of prayer help keep us focused when we are praying. You may not always pray for each type every time but it helps to have some direction while we are praying.

"Now, let's break up into 4 groups and each group take a type of prayer to practice together. Here are some prompts to get each group started:

- 1. **Silence & Solitude:** Pray that God would remove distractions from your mind and help you hear what He wants to say. Feel free to take notes as you feel the Holy Spirit reveal things to you or to read your Bible during this time of prayer.
- 2. **Intercessory Prayer**: Share requests in your group and pray over those together. Pray for your school, your teachers, your administrators, your community.
- 3. **Adoration**: share 1 or 2 things God is doing in your life that you are thankful for. Then spend some time just giving God thanks and telling Him all the things you love about Him.
- 4. **Praying for the lost**: Pray for lost friends or family who don't have a relationship with God. Pray for the lost community and those in nations and places that have never heard of Jesus.

TIP: Have a strong Student Leader or Adult Volunteer in each group to help lead the prayers. Make sure groups have plenty of time to pray - this can be such a powerful time in their lives and your club!



(Have a Student Leader close groups by praying out loud once everyone is done).
