## Foundation Scripture

"And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near." Hebrews 10:24-25

### **OPENING PRAYER**

## **SPEAKER**

**TIP**: have a Student Leader make a chart on the board with two columns: 1. Struggles 2. How to Overcome. They can fill in the chart as the discussion happens.

(Close discussion)

"Let's review some of the things we talked about today (read through what is written on the board or what was discussed in groups).

It makes sense because we are all sinners and far from perfect that their would be issues and problems when we gather together for one purpose. By the way, that is what the word "fellowship" actually means: participation with others that share a common purpose. Even what we are doing here at First Priority is considered fellowship.

Fellowship is a really cool thing. It brings unity within the Church (or God's family), it brings us closer to God, and it serves those around us. When we fellowship, we build one another up (Romans 14:19), serve one another (Galatians 5:13),
