- Be involved with First Priority network meetings and communicate regularly with your First Priority Director.
- As the Student Leadership Team initiates conversations with you relating to the club, always encourage the leadership to fulfill the purpose they committed to in their Club Constitution and to discuss any denominational issues with their local church.
- Involve your church in the ministry of First Priority by developing prayer initiatives, supporting through missions giving, providing volunteers for events and helping us find potential Campus Coaches and Priority Parents.
- Be a follower of Jesus Christ and maintain an active relationship in a local church that is in agreement with our statement of faith, avoiding disqualifying behavior that Scripture forbids (Galatians 5:19-21, 1 Corinthians 6:9-10), and setting a positive biblical example "in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity" (1 Timothy 4:12, c.f. Galatians 5:22-25).
- Follow the Two Adult Rule at all times. If one supervising adult must leave a group of students, another volunteer or employee must be notified so that the Two Adult Rule can be followed. If two individuals serving in a room are related to one another, a third unrelated volunteer or staff member must be present.
