WHAT DOES FIRST PRIORITY LOOK LIKE FOR STUDENTS?

The First Priority Club meets weekly at school during non-curricular time. The club engages students on these four levels:

- 1. Students are **equipped** to share the Gospel.
- 2. Students are **empowered** to share their story of faith in Jesus.
- 3. Students **invite** their non-believing friends to hear about the Hope of Christ.
- 4. Students talk about the importance of being **connected** to Jesus, the club and a local church.

FOLLOW-UP PROCESS:

Students can express a desire for a peer to follow up with them, which often results in their attending a local youth ministry for the first time and becoming connected to a local church for discipleship.
