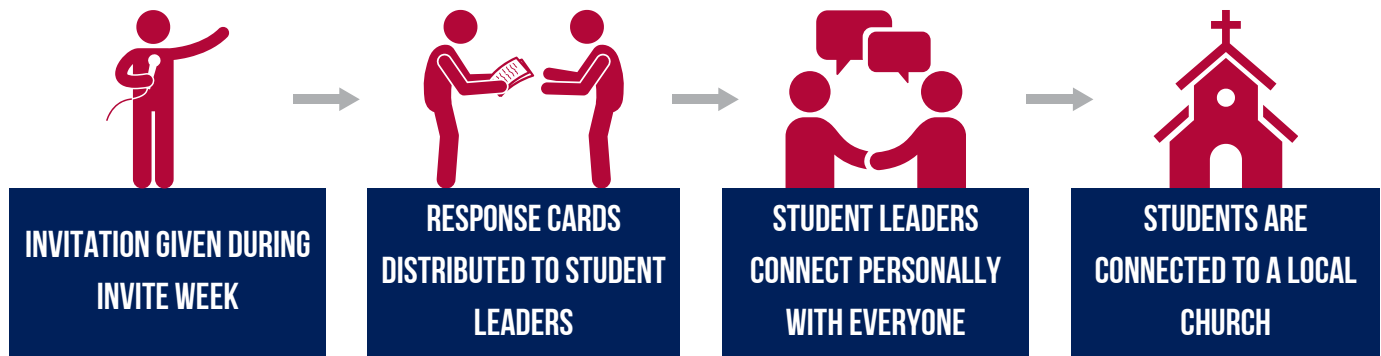


FOLLOW UP GUIDE



GOAL: EVERY PERSON SHOULD FEEL CONNECTED TO CHRIST, YOUR CLUB, AND THE LOCAL CHURCH.



KEYS TO SUCCESS

- Focus on Relationships
 - **Keep it Genuine!**
- Personalize the Conversations
 - Do your best to connect deeper by asking about their interests and building on that foundation.
- Keep Follow-Up Peer-to-Peer
 - Girls should follow up with girls, and boys should follow up with boys. Look for mutual friendships and possible established relationships with leaders already in the club.

DURING INVITE WEEK

- The follow-up coordinator should pass out the response cards and ask everyone in the room to fill out a card.
 - Note: Ask everyone to fill out the cards so that it does not isolate students and make them feel uncomfortable.
- Collect all cards and sort them based on the boxes they checked.
 - Count each category and report them in the Club Meeting Report in the FP Club app.
- Divide the cards among all Student Leaders.
 - Remember to keep the gender the same and keep the grades similar if possible.
 - It's also best to make mutual connections when sorting the cards.

RESPONSE CARD NEXT STEP ACTIONS

“TODAY, I TRUSTED IN JESUS FOR THE FIRST TIME.”

This is the most exciting response you can get! It's time to celebrate!

- Message this person within 24 hours of their response and celebrate!
- Schedule a meeting as soon as possible to hear their story and ask questions. Hear about what God is doing in their life!
- Give them a First Priority Bible and offer to walk through the new believer's guide with them. (firstpriority.club/resources)
- Invite them to your church or offer to find a church that best fits their needs.
- Offer to connect them to your youth pastor to continue following up.

“TODAY, I REAFFIRMED MY FAITH IN JESUS.”

What a great response to someone whose faith is affirmed! This might also be considered a “rededication.”

- Message this person within 24 hours of their response to celebrate!
- Schedule a meeting as soon as possible to hear their story and ask questions. Hear about what God is doing in their life!
- They may already attend church, but if not, invite them to your church.
- Offer to connect them to your youth pastor to continue following up.

I WOULD “LIKE MORE INFORMATION ABOUT THE GOSPEL.”

This response is so encouraging. It means that someone is contemplating faith, and they need more answers!

- Message this person within 24 hours of their response and offer support!
 - Schedule a meeting with them as soon as possible. At the meeting, ask them what they know about the Gospel.
 - Focus on asking questions and listening to their response.
 - Asking questions shows that you care about them and their journey.
- Offer to connect this person to your youth pastor to continue following up and help them connect to a local church.

“I HAVE TRUSTED IN JESUS BEFORE TODAY.”

Don't neglect this response! You might find a new Student Leader through this response!

- Message this person within 24 hours to see if they might be interested in joining the Student Leader team at your school!

“I AM NOT INTERESTED.”

This one might be a little discouraging sometimes. However, don't ignore these.

- Message this person within 24 hours, thanking them for joining the club meeting!
- Let them know they are always welcome to attend club meetings and offer to talk with the individually if they need to chat or ask any questions.

If you don't get a response to your first message, wait a few days and try again. If there is no response, invite them to your next club meeting and pray they show up!
