

- Attend all club meetings as required under the Equal Access Act (20 U.S.C. 4071-74).
- Be aware of school regulations to make sure the club functions in accordance with policies and procedures and submit a club constitution to your administration, completed at your first meeting.
- Act as a liaison on behalf of the students to the school administration.
- Make sure the meeting room is open and ready before weekly meetings.
- Attend planning meetings as a chaperone/observer.
- Seek to understand the purpose of a First Priority club so you may be an informed chaperone/observer.
- Provide printed resources for students.
- Keep an accurate record of attendance, which will assist in follow through with students. Your administration may also request a copy.
