Club Formation: Facilitate the formation of First Priority clubs by recruiting student leaders, organizing meetings, and guiding the establishment of club structure and objectives.

Training and Support: Provide training and ongoing support to student leaders to ensure effective club leadership, organization, and adherence to First Priority guidelines.

Relationship Building: Cultivate positive relationships with school administrators, teachers, and community members to garner support for First Priority clubs and ensure their sustainability.

Reporting and Documentation: Maintain accurate records of club activities, membership, and impact. Provide regular reports to First Priority of America regarding club progress and effectiveness.
